**LETTER OF INTENT  
BETWEEN  
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA  
AND  
THE WORLD WATER COUNCIL  
AND  
THE AFRICAN MINISTER'S COUNCIL ON WATER  
ON  
COOPERATION TO SUPPORT THE ORGANIZATION OF  
THE 10<sup>TH</sup> WORLD WATER FORUM**

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia, the World Water Council, and the African Minister's Council on Water, hereinafter individually referred to as the "Party" and collectively referred to as the "Parties";

**REFERRING** to the Framework Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Indonesia and the World Water Council for the Organization of the 10th World Water Forum, signed in Jakarta and Cairo on 15 October 2022;

**CONSIDERING** that the African Minister's Council on Water (AMCOW) stands as a pivotal organization dedicated to fostering cooperation, socio-economic development, and effective management of Africa's water resources. As coordinators of the Africa Region of the Regional Process for the 10<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum, AMCOW exemplifies a commitment to devising comprehensive solutions tailored to the region's distinct water challenges. The role of AMCOW highlights the importance of the Africa Regional Process, addressing the multifaceted water needs for shared prosperity;

**CONSIDERING** that Indonesia demonstrates a commitment to global water issues, including its active involvement in resolving water challenges in the global water community and the hosting of the 10<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum to be held in Bali, Indonesia, in 2024 as well as in its contribution to the implementation different initiatives and solutions to tackle regional water issues;

**CONSIDERING** that the World Water Council is an international multi-stakeholder platform whose mission is to stimulate action on critical water issues at all levels, including the highest decision-making level, while focusing primarily on political dimensions of water security, adaptation, and sustainability to position water at the top of the global political agenda and that the World Water Council is as the owner of the "World Water Forum" brand which is the largest world event dedicated to water and as such, co-host with the host country of the 10<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum;

**WHEREAS** the Parties have conducted consultations regarding the support that intended to jointly provide in the preparation of the Africa Regional Process, the 10<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum;

By this Letter of Intent, the Parties acting within the framework of joint and concerted cooperation, express their intention to carry out common activities with a view to successfully organize the 10<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum to be held in Bali in May 2024. The activities to be undertaken by the Parties shall be subject to subsequent agreements to specify the roles and responsibilities of each Party.

This Letter of Intent does not create rights and obligations under international law among the Parties.


